We are quite clear that some of the principles promulgated by our friends further north, and generally accepted as true, are not the most applicable in this latitude and farther south. We have not concerned ourselves with the manufacture of cheese, with the concentration and canning of milk, nor with the utilization of any of the by-products. Our skim-milk goes for feed, and our cream is either disposed of as cream, or as butter. The energies of the Station in this investigation have been concentrated upon the problems of handling milk and cream, so as to make the...
