The disease was first recognised as plague in the first week of January, but there can be little doubt that deaths had occurred from plague at an earlier period. The registration of deaths in Accra is in a very unsatisfactory state in several ways and one of them is that it does not give the necessary information which would at once enable the Government to become cognisant of the existence of any infectious disease or the threatening of an epidemic; at present it is useless as a record of the cause of death. This defect in the registration, I understand, will be remedied, and it is very important that it should be,...
